Master Teacher's Column

The Neuroscience of Learning

NEUROSCIENCE

What do we pay attention to?

What are the things that engage and inspire us? How do we 'hook' our children into learning? What interests them? What matters to them? How can we ensure that we make connections with them?

ATTENTION

THE BRAIN FOCUSES ON WHAT IS IMPORTANT, ENJOYABLE AND INTERESTING OR NOVEL. DOPAMINE IS RELEASED DURING THESE TIMES TO REINFORCE LEARNING

Our brain is constantly being bombarded with information received through our senses. If we paid attention to everything at once, our brain would be overwhelmed with information. So what do our brains pay attention to? The brain filters information and looks for what is important, enjoyable, interesting or novel. During these times dopamine is released. This helps to reinforce learning (IMPACT Learning Framework).



What our brains pay attention to is a bit different for everyone – Some of the most common things are telling stories that are relatable, things that trigger emotions, being around people that make us feel good, having a laugh, and even things that are threatening.

In our classrooms, we are embedding the ever-emerging field of cognitive neuroscience into our teaching methods to enhance the learning for all of our students. We are doing this through the 'IMPACT Learning Framework'. This framework provides us with a deeper understanding of the limitations of the brain and how it learns so that we understand why successful teaching practices work. This way we can ensure that we have the greatest positive IMPACT on learning.
