Our overseas visitors have just left and Madame Wada said that a great time was had by all. It's a huge job that Madame Wada does every year with our visitors and always with a smile on her face. Thank you to all our families who hosted our visitors. We are about to send our contingent overseas and we are sure they will have a fabulous time and enjoy the wonderful opportunity of being able to travel abroad at such a young age.

Just a reminder that it is important for you to let us know if your family is moving on from Caningeraba at the end of 2016, as it enables us to complete our planning to the best of our ability. Please let your child's class teacher know if your child will not be returning next year and return the notes sent home as soon as possible.

Attendance is important – every day counts – right up to the last day of the term!

Parents and caregivers must send children to school every school day under Queensland law unless there is an acceptable reason such as:

- illness
- doing work experience
- competing in school sporting events.

If your child is going to be absent from school, you must let the school know why the absence has occurred within two school days of their return. If possible, it is best to advise the school beforehand.

Avoid keeping your child away from school for reasons such as:

- birthdays
- shopping
- visiting family and friends
- if they sleep in
- looking after other children
- minor check ups or care, such as hair cuts, etc.

Routine medical or other health appointments should be made either before or after school or during the school holidays.

Establishing good routines around school can assist with regular school attendance. These include:

- have a set time to go to bed
- have a set time to get out of bed
- have uniform and school bag ready the night before
- have a set time for starting and finishing breakfast
- set a time for daily homework activities
- speak about school positively
- send your child to school every school day including their birthday and the last day of term from Prep.

If you are experiencing difficulty in sending your child to school, contact your teacher for support. We can work together to ensure that your child is engaged in school and is on the way to being a happy, healthy and confident 21st century learner.

Simply drop your boots into the Red collection bin in the School Admin Office.

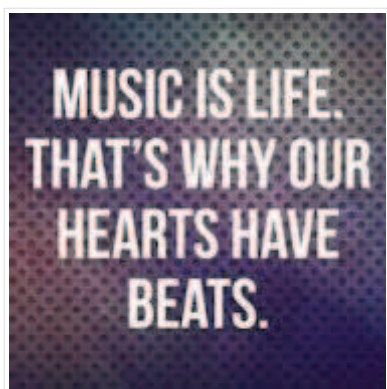
We will be collecting boots until the 11th of November.
