2017 School Opinion Survey

Information regarding the 2017 School Opinion Survey will be sent home next week with the eldest student in each family. (Keep an eye out for a blue form with **School Opinion Survey** at the top). This survey will give you the opportunity to have your say about what our school does well, and how it can improve.

Participation in the survey will be anonymous and all information you provide will be treated confidentially. You will be able to complete the survey online by following the instructions on the blue information form and using the codes provided to log in. **The survey will open on Monday 31 July and will close on Friday 25 August.** We hope to have as many parents/caregivers as possible complete the survey in order to obtain some truly meaningful feedback. Of course, participation in the survey is purely voluntary, but the information it provides is very important to us, so we hope you will be able to spare some time to complete the survey after you receive it next week.

Homework Help

By making sure support and encouragement are given in generous quantities, you can help your child to view homework in a positive light.

- Give your child praise for efforts and for completing tasks.
- Remember, everyone makes mistakes, so don't expect perfection all the time.

- Encourage your child to do the work independently but be available for assistance.
- Establish a set time to do homework each day. You may want to use a calendar to keep track of due dates for assignments.
- Provide a set space for doing homework, stocked with necessary supplies such as pencils, paper, dictionary etc.
- Remove distractions such as TV, radio and interruptions from siblings.
- Talk to your child about difficulties with homework. Be willing to talk to your child's teacher to resolve problems in a positive way.
- Familiarise yourself with the class homework policy. Make sure you and your child understand the teacher's expectations.

Always remember that the teacher's primary motivation is to help your child. But just as a good parent rewards good behaviour and implements consequences for poor behaviour to help their child learn right from wrong, the teacher is likely to have rewards and consequences in place for the completion of homework. Students, especially as they grow older, need to be encouraged to take responsibility for their own actions, so it is important that parents are supportive of any system of rewards or consequences the teacher puts in place.

An excellent way of reducing potential homework 'drama' is to encourage children not to wait till the last minute to start their homework. If they make a start on their homework and peruse all activities early in the week they will have plenty of time to ask their teacher about anything they are unsure of, instead of going into a panic on the last night when they strike problems.

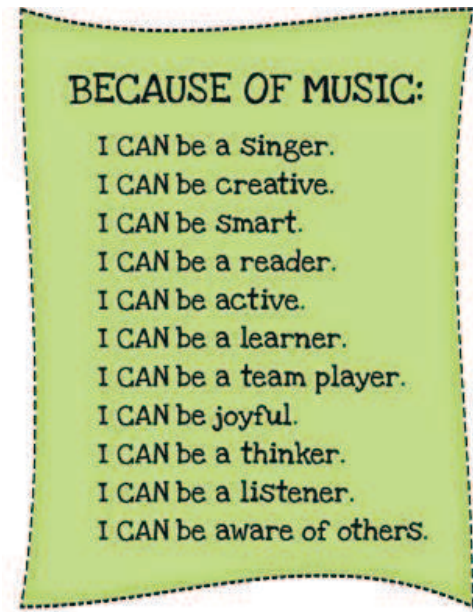
